CALL FOR ENROLMENT

KAGURA JAPANESE LANGUAGE SCHOOL

1. ADMISSION COURSE

- 1-year and 6-month: enroll in October.
- 2-year course: enroll in April.

Basically, this is a preparatory course for students who wish to continue their studies at College or University.

After graduation, if students wish to work (limited to students who have graduated from University in their home country), or wish to switch to a Specific Skills visa, the school will provide specific advice.

2. APPLICATION CONDITIONS

Students who want to participate in the course (advanced course for students who wish to study at Secondary, College, University), must satisfy the following 3 conditions:

- Students wishing to enter post-secondary higher education institutions in Japan must have completed 12 years of high school education outside of Japan (6 years of elementary school, 3 years of junior high school, 3 years of high school), or be eligible to attend their homeland universities.
- 2) Students who have studied Japanese for over 150 hours and passed the Japanese language certificate equivalent to N5 or higher: 2-year advanced course, 1-year and 6-month advanced course.
- 3) Students have never stayed illegally in Japan in the past, including family members and relatives.

3. APPLICATION PROCESS

Students who wish to enroll must first take the entrance exam.

1. Register for entrance exam

Students who wish to enroll, please fill in the necessary items in the attached "Application for Entrance Examination" and then send it to Kagura Japanese Language School by fax or post. After receiving the application, the school will provide specific instructions on the date, time and location of the examination.

2. Registration deadline

1 year 6 month course: from February ~ mid April.

2-year course: from September ~ mid-November.

3. Exam content

Japanese, writing (mother tongue), interview.

4. SUBMIT APPLICATION (After passing the entrance exam)

After receiving notice of passing the entrance exam, students please submit the following documents:

Note: If the candidate does not submit the application by the deadline, the school will cancel the results.


1. Documents related to students

- 1) Documents according to the school's prescribed form: admission form, resume, reason for studying abroad.
- 2) Documents from the issuing agencies: Japanese language certificate, graduation certificate, transcript, passport copy, notarized family register, and other documents as required by the school.
- 3) ID photo: 10 3x4cm photos taken within 3 months.

2. Documents proving ability to pay tuition and living expenses

- 1) Form as prescribed by the school: financial guarantee form.
- 2) Documents from the issuing agencies: Documents proving the process of asset formation and the ability to pay expenses (certificate of savings balance, notarized copy of savings book clearly showing the process of asset formation in the last 3 years, certificate of employment, documents related to tax payment...), documents proving the relationship between the student and the financial sponsor (documents proving personal relationship...). And other documents as required by the school.

7. ABOUT CANCELLATION OF FILES

The school will collect 50,000 yen application fee and admission fee in the following cases:

1/ Cancel the application after passing the Certificate of Eligibility (COE).

2/ Visa rejection at embassy or consulate.

3/ Cancel the application after getting a visa at the embassy or consulate.

- Cancellation of application without payment of tuition and fees: please transfer 50,000 yen to the designated account within 30 days from the date of cancellation.
- Cancellation after paying tuition and fees: Please return the original COE and admission notice to the school. After receiving the
 documents, the school will refund after deducting 50,000 yen. Refunds will be made within 30 days from the date of cancellation.
 Students will be responsible for any costs related to the bank refund.

8. DORMITORY: The school will lend bicycles for free.

1. **Dormitory**

- In case of dormitory: students can move out of the dormitory after 6 months from the date of moving in.
